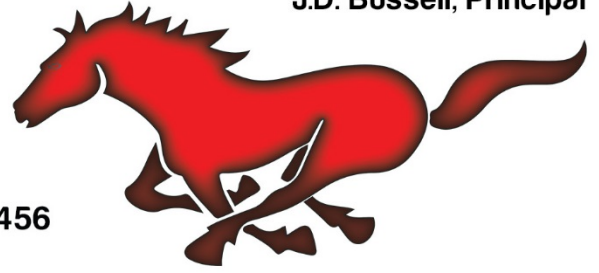

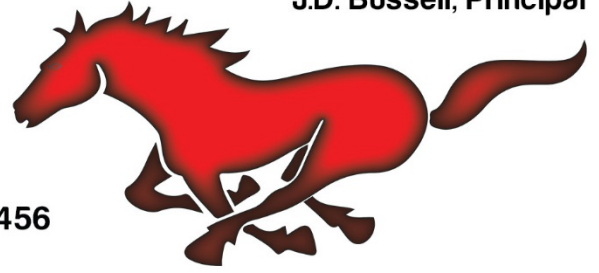

All students need these items:

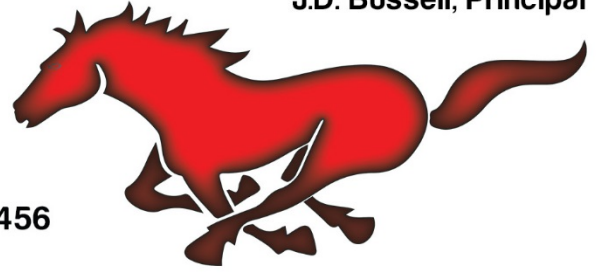
- 2 Boxes of 8 Crayola crayons

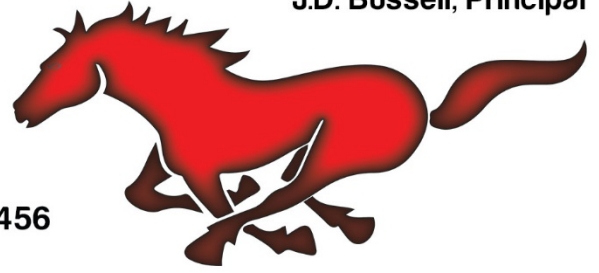

You will need:

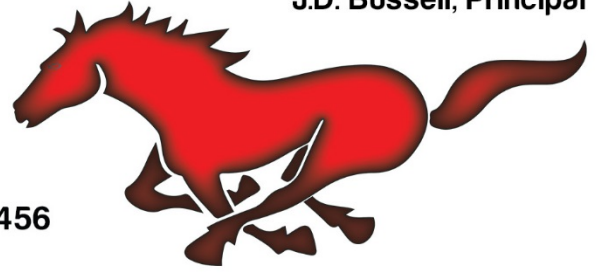
- A backpack

- \$5.00 for a school T-Shirt

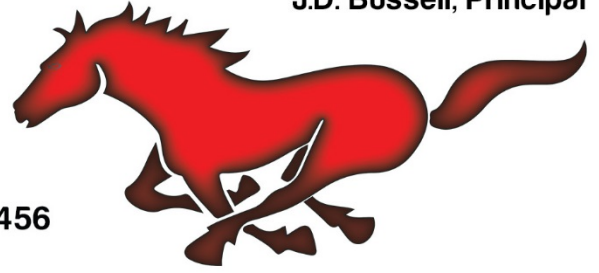
Wish List

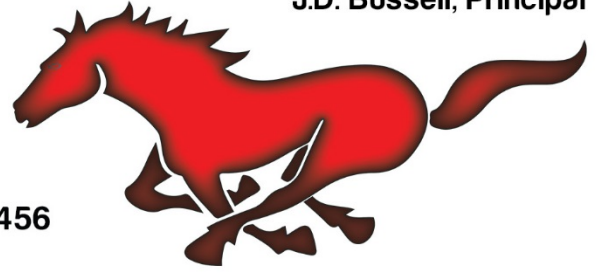
